Undergraduate and Graduate Admission Regulations for the *Elective Studies* Program, established by the University of São Paulo School of Dentistry International Office (CRInt-FOUSP).

The following regulations apply to foreign applicants who intend to join the Program:

I – About the Program

The *Elective Studies* Program was created for undergraduate and graduate students coming from foreign universities, which may have agreements with the School or not, who intend to get to know the activities of the University of São Paulo School of Dentistry, through a specific activity schedule organized by the Committee itself with the support of other professors, departments, clinics and laboratories. Students in this Program are expected to spend the equivalent of a week or two (short-term exchange), depending on the call published by CRInt-FOUSP.

II - The Activities

- For the *Elective Studies* Program, the activities take place in the second academic term, always in the beginning of August.
- Students are previously selected by their home institution to participate in activities
 organized by the University of São Paulo School of Dentistry International Office, which
 take place throughout the two weeks of the visit. They may also join lectures, laboratory
 classes and clinical care activities as OBSERVERS, that is, without directly taking part of
 procedures.
- Students may also conduct research projects, once the USP professor who is responsible for them present prior approval by the FOUSP Ethics in Research Committee, in case of research with humans.
- The activity schedule cannot be extended.

III - Requirements

- The student must be properly enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate course in Dentistry.

IV - Documents for the application (in English or Spanish)

- A letter written by the home institution, addressed to the FOUSP International Office and to the Professor responsible, confirming the approval of the student to participate in the program.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- A photo (size: 3x4) in JPEG format, with a maximum of 50kb.
- Application form, available on the website.

V - Deadline for submissions



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Taking into account the schedule of the program, we shall receive the documents from June 1st to 10th via post or email.
